

Easy Grid Hand Towel

100 grams sport weight linen yarn* such as Louet Euroflax
 US 4 or 5 needles or size to obtain desired fabric
 2 stitch markers

Multiple of 10 +1

	Knit on RS Purl on WS
--	Purl on RS, Knit on WS

Cast on 81 stitches. Knit 5 rows in chosen border pattern (garter or seed stitch).
 Knit 5 stitches in chosen border pattern, place marker,
 follow chart for 7 repeats (only knit grey stitches on 7th repeat). Place marker, knit 5 stitches in chosen border pattern.
 Begin chart, keeping first five stitches and last five stitches in garter or seed on every row. (Use stitch markers to indicate border stitches)
 Pattern can be widened or narrowed in multiples of 10.
 You should be able to do 13 or 14 repeats of the rows of the chart.
 End with last five rows in garter or seed stitch.

Border Patterns

Seed stitch: K1, *P1, K1 (repeat from *) on every row).
 Garter Stitch: Knit across every row.

*If you use a heavier weight yarn, cast on 10 less stitches.

Machine wash and dry until slightly damp. Block lightly into shape to finish drying.
 Linen blooms slightly when washed and becomes softer with each wash.
